4  **- The Skin**

- **As we all know, the skin of a shark is very rough**
- **This is due to the type of scales that cover the body**
- **The scales are known as placoid**
- **They are represented by the kisses on my project**

5  **They look like this...**

6  **-Scales**

- **The scales do not grow with the shark, more are simply added as it gets larger**
- **They serve to protect the shark**

7  **Teeth**

- **Sharks, like many other animals, have teeth**
- **They use these teeth to rip and tear meat off of the animal that they are eating (sharks are good at this)**
- **The teeth are represented by Mike and Ikes on my project**

9  **-Teeth**

- **The teeth are not in bone, but instead reside in the flesh**
- **They may lose 30,000 teeth in a lifetime**
- **Takes about 8-10 days**
- **Top row of teeth are for holding the prey, whilst the bottom row tears**

- **A shark may have thousands**
- **They detect electronic pulses in the water**
- **May be for navigation**
- **They are represented on my project by sprinkles**
